Summary

Rhythm of Hope- Ethiopia organized a cardiac pacemaker implantation mission on February 24th 2024, providing cardiac pacemaker implantation for 6 patients. All patients were successfully discharged with improvements.

Major milestone in our partnership

May, 2021	First mission at the CCE and 12 patients received implantations.		
February, 2022	Second mission at the CCE and St. Peter Hospital with 8 patients benefited from the mission. Pacemaker programmer and additional consumables were donated.		
December, 2022	Third mission at the CCE and St. Peter's Hospital and 8 patients benefited from the mission.		
January, 2024	Fourth mission at the CCE and St. Peter's Hospital and 8 patients benefited from the mission.		
February, 2025	Fifth mission at the CCE and St. peter's hospital and 6 patients benefited and 4 more pacemakers with lead were donated.		

Patient selections and pre-procedure activities

- A total of 10 patients selected and screened by our Interventional cardiologists, out of which 6 patients got the implantation in our center on Feb 24,2025.
- Cardiac lesions addressed during the mission
 - AV block
 - Battery changes

• A total of 9 procedures were performed for 9 distinct patients during the mission.

- Cardiology fellows from Black Lion Hospital and St. Paul's Hospital participated in the mission,
 gaining practical experience during the pre-procedure, procedure, and post-procedure activities.
- Two interventional cardiologists, radiographers and six cardiac catheterization nurses participated in the mission, gaining valuable practical experience.
